The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is hosting the final series of public information meetings regarding the I-84 New Mix Waterbury Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study in March and April.

The purpose of the New Mix Program is to address the long-term needs of the Interstate 84 and Route 8 interchange, which is a vital structure forming part of the greater Waterbury transportation system.

The New Mix team will be sharing results from the study, including recommendations and final alternatives, reimagining the future of the Mixmaster. The public and community stakeholders are encouraged to offer feedback and ask questions regarding the program.
